Gabapentin: Why is this medication prescribed?

Gabapentin is used to treat nerve pain conditions such as diabetic neuropathy, peripheral neuropathy, and trigeminal neuralgia. It is also used to relieve nerve pain associated with shingles (herpes zoster) infection in adults. Gabapentin has also been used with other medications to help control seizures in adults and children (3 years of age and older). Antacids containing aluminum or magnesium may interfere with the absorption of this medication. Therefore, it is best to take Gabapentin at least 2 hours after taking an antacid.

Theramine™ : Why is this medication prescribed?

Theramine is a Medical Food product designed to aid in the nutritional management of pain syndromes. **Theramine** stimulates production of serotonin, GABA, norepinephrine, nitric oxide and acetylcholine, the neurotransmitters that are involved in pain disorders. If the timing and secretion of these neurotransmitters are effectively modulated, acute and chronic pain disorders are more effectively managed. **Theramine** provides L-arginine at low dose along with choline and L-glutamine to inhibit the NMDA and opioid receptors.

Theramine aids in the nutritional management of serotonin, GABA, and acetylcholine production deficiencies in patients with pain syndromes.

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
